This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of the impugned order dated 15.02.2020 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in FIR no.148 dated 25.10.2019 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

On 05.07.2022, a coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“The instant application has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for seeking extension of time for further 15 days for surrendering before Ld. Trial Court in compliance to order dated 27.05.2022.
