Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking direction to respondent No.2 to monitor the investigation of case FIR No.0079 dated 09.05.2022, Annexure P-2, registered for offences under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short "IPC") read with Section 34, IPC, at Police Station Division No.5, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar and to take appropriate action on the representation dated 16.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the daughter of the petitioner was married to Ravi Daliya on 29.10.2011 and sufficient dowry articles and gifts were given to her at the time of her marriage. However, her husband and in-laws were not satisfied and had been repeatedly harassing, maltreating and tormenting her. Counsel submits that a compromise dated 29.10.2019, Annexure P-1, had taken place, but despite the same, the torture of the petitioner's daughter continued and unfortunately, she was killed by her in-laws. Counsel submits that the

petitioner has lodged FIR, Annexure P-2, but as no action was being taken thereon, he submitted representation, Annexure P-4, to the official respondents, which has also not yielded any result. He submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to look into the representation, Annexure P-4.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents. Upon instructions received from ASI, Nirmal Singh, he submits that the deceased has left behind a suicide note, where she has not specifically named anyone and the said note has been sent to FSL for analysis.

Having considered the submissions made by counsel for the parties, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar, Jalandhar City, Punjab-respondent No.2, to examine the representation, Annexure P-4, and take suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.
