RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral)

Having argued the matter at length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw the petition, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the authorities concerned, by filing a comprehensive representation, for mitigation of its grievances.

Mr. Shobit Phutela, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Union of India, on advance copy, submits that if any such representation is submitted by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously, in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty prayed for.

However, it is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion in favour of the petitioner or otherwise and, therefore, the authorities would be at liberty to examine the matter keeping all facts and facets into consideration and thereafter accept or reject the same in accordance with law.
