Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has already retired from service on attaining the age of superannuation on 30.09.2021 but, except the benefits of gratuity, arrears of pension and commutation of pension, other benefits have not been released to her so far. Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that the petitioner is entitled to receive all the pensionary benefits within a period of two months after her retirement, but the respondents are not releasing the same despite being any impediment.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by serving upon them legal notice dated 26.03.2022 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 26.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the legal notice dated 26.03.2022 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for the monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notices, the same be also paid to her within four weeks thereafter.
