Vide the instant petition filed under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.89 dated 03.05.2022, Annexure P-1, registered under Sections 376, 506 and 120-B of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

Upon instructions from ASI Ramlal, State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 26.05.2022 and she is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

It has been submitted that interim bail granted to co-accused, Pardeep Singh Bhatti @ Pardeep Singh in CRM-M-26508-2022, has been made absolute by this Court by an order passed on even date.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the petition, present petition is allowed and order dated 26.05.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
