The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondent nos.2 & 3 to decide representation dated 13.07.2020 (Annexure P-2) given by the petitioner and not to harass the petitioner at the instance of respondent nos.4 to 11. There is a further prayer to direct the respondents nos.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and take strict action against respondent nos.4 to 11.

None has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

The Counsel for the State submits that the statement of the petitioner Pardeep Kaur has been recorded as per which she has entered into a panchayati divorce with her husband Gurdarshan Singh and is currently residing with Sukhwinder Singh pursuant to a compromise which has been effected between the parties.

passed in the present petition.
