Despite the fact case has been called out twice, there is no representation on behalf of petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Gurtej Singh submits that petitioner – **Nirmal Singh @ Bittu** has already been acquitted by the Trial Court in the instant case FIR, vide judgment of acquittal dated 25.11.2022, which fact is duly mentioned in the custody certificate dated 28.11.2022, placed on record today by respondent-State and as such instant petition seeking regular bail has become infructuous.

Apart from that, the status updated on the website of e-courts services shows that petitioner – **Nirmal Singh @ Bittu** has already been acquitted by the Trial Court in the instant case FIR, vide judgment of acquittal dated 25.11.2022.

In view of above, since petitioner has already been acquitted of charge by Trial Court in the instant case FIR, vide judgment of acquittal dated 25.11.2022, instant petition seeking regular bail moved by petitioner is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.
