This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the office of respondent No.2 to 6 to release the amount of compensation as entitled under the Welfare Scheme qua Insurance and Funeral Assistance & Pension including arrears of pension to the petitioner.

Even on second call, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. The previous order dated 28.10.2022 shows that the petitioner had furnished an undertaking to the respondent-department that she does not want to pursue with the present petition. On the previous date, learned counsel for the petitioner also sought time to verify the fact about the petitioner having received the amount from the respondent-department. Today, learned counsel has not come present to rebut the assertion made by the State.

In view of the above, it is obvious that the claim of the petitioner has been satisfied and she does not want to press the present petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
