Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the husband of the petitioner was working in the Education Department of the respondents and unfortunately died while in service on 21.09.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for the service benefits including the financial assistance keeping in view the fact that the husband of the petitioner died while in service. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits the petitioner has no other source of survival and is running from pillar to post to get her dues for which she is entitled, in respect of the service rendered by her husband.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by serving upon them legal notice dated 10.03.2022 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 10.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the legal notice dated 10.03.2022 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for the monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notices, the same be also released to her within four weeks thereafter.
