Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned result dated 10.04.2022 (Annexure P-6) qua BCA category for the post of Staff Nurse against advertisement No.15/2019 dated 07.09.2019

2. Haryana Staff Selection Commission advertised 1584 posts of Staff Nurse under Category No.10, out of which, 209 posts were reserved for BCA category. The petitioner, being eligible, applied for the said post under BCA category. She appeared in the written examination and secured 61 marks. Thereafter she was called for scrutiny of documents. The cut off marks of the last selected candidate is 50, which is 11 marks less than the marks obtained by the petitioner. However, when the result was declared, her name did not figure in the selection list.

3. Qua the aforesaid grievance, petitioner also submitted a representation dated 18.04.2022 (Annexure P-7) but the same has not been adverted till date. Hence the petition.

4. On advance service, learned state counsel appears and submits that a decision will be taken by competent authority, either way, on the pending representation dated 18.04.2022 (Annexure P-7) by passing a speaking order.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also seeks decision on the pending representation as suggested by learned State counsel.

6. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

7. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the representation dated 18.04.2022 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner and pass an administrative order, in accordance with law.

8. Let the needful be done within a period of 30 days from today and in any case, not later than issuing appointment letter to any candidate who is below the petitioner in the merit list, to avoid creating any 3rd party rights.

9. Disposed of accordingly.
