VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to official respondents to complete the investigation in case bearing FIR No.31 dated 07.03.2018 under Sections 419, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur in accordance with law.

A status report by way of an affidavit of Rajwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Zira, District Ferozepur has already been filed. Copy thereof already stands furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioner. The relevant extract of the same is reproduced herein below:

5. That on the basis of said application, enquiry was conducted by SHO Police Station Zira and during enquiry all the allegations leveled by the complainant against accused persons were found to be genuine. After obtaining opinion from DA (L), present case was registered.

6. *That during investigation of the case accused Lakhwinder Singh was joined in investigation on 01.10.2018 in compliance of order passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur, after that accused Saraj Singh was joined in investigation on 17.03.2020, Balwant Singh was joined in investigation on 15.10.2020, whereas accused Jeet Singh was died on 01.07.2020.*

7. *That after completion of investigation challan against Saraj Singh, Balwant Singh, Karaj Singh and Lakhwinder Singh was presented before the Ld. Court of Illaqa Magistrate, Zira on 07.12.2020 and now case is fixed for 01.04.2021 for appearance of accused.”*

A perusal of the above shows that the investigation has already been concluded and the final report under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. has also been filed and the matter is now pending before the trial Court.

In view of the above, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that she does not want to press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
