Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present case, the petitioner was re-instated in service with the respondent-Department, with all the consequential benefits and full back wages, vide order dated 05.09.2016 (Annexure P-2), passed by the Additional Chief Secretary, Health Department, Haryana, which order has not been implemented by the respondents so far, hence the respondents are liable to be directed to implement the said order dated 05.09.2016 without any further delay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the same grievance has also been raised by the petitioner before the respondents by serving legal notice dated 25.03.2022 (Annexure P-8), which is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 25.03.2022, by passing an appropriate

speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, Additional A.G., Haryana, keeping in view the advance service of the copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State and raises no objection, in case prayer made hereinbefore on behalf of the petitioner for deciding the legal notice dated 25.03.2022 (Annexure P-8) in a time bound manner is accepted.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioner in the present case as well as in the legal notice dated 25.03.2022 (Annexure P-8), this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to pass an appropriate speaking order on the legal notice dated 25.03.2022 (Annexure P-8), filed by the petitioner, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
