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**ARUN MONGA, J. (ORAL)**

Petitioners herein, *inter alia*, seek issuance of a writ in the nature of prohibition restraining the respondents from terminating the services of the petitioners on different posts Sweeper/Chowkidar in Group-D/IV despite the work and conduct being satisfactory.

2. *Qua* the claim of the petitioners to allow them to continue working on contractual jobs, the same seems to have been rendered infructuous as learned counsel for the petitioners submits that have been allowed to continue in service.

3. Accordingly, writ petition is disposed of with expectation that the respondents shall allow the petitioners to continue, unless of course services are still required and/or regular appointments are to be made on the post in question. Needless to say, petitioners shall be entitled to salary, subject to work being taken from them.

4. At this stage, learned State counsel submits that the State Government has taken a decision to outsource all the contractual employees

through the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam. Respondents shall be at liberty to depute the services of the petitioners through said Nigam.
