AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed seeking directions to the official respondents for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners as they had solemnised marriage against wishes of their parents.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the petitioners were kept in Protection House at Panchkula. Thereafter, statements of father, uncle and brother of petitioner No. 1 have been recorded. They have stated that they have no objection to the marriage solemnised by petitioner No. 1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners no longer want to stay in Protection House as there is no threat perception as on date. He further submits that in case need so arises in future, the petitioners will approach the police authorities.

In view of the above, the petition stands disposed of.

The petitioners may be allowed to leave the Protection House.
