[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 31.07.2018, in CWP No.18734 of 2018 in case titled as '**Sadhu Singh and others** versus **State of Punjab and others.**'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.18734 of 2018, was disposed of by directing the respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioners as contained in legal notice dated 03.04.2018 and take a conscious decision in respect thereto in accordance with law, rules and regulations within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Notice has yet not been issued in the instant case.

[4] However, learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset states that speaking order dated 20.09.2019 passed in the instant case has been supplied to the petitioners and that in the circumstances, he does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
