HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J.(Oral)

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.99 dated 28.04.2022, registered under Sections 384 and 389 IPC read with Section 34 IPC, at Police Station City Safidon, District Jind, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case and that the present FIR is a counter-blast to FIR No.91 dated 20.04.2022, under Sections 2, 9, 39, 44, 48, 49, 51 and 55 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, Police Station City Safidon, District Jind, registered against Ashish Kumar Garg, brother of the complainant herein.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

The allegations against the petitioner are specific and serious in nature, inasmuch as, he took Rs.50,000/- from the complainant, under

pressure and on the pretext that if the said amount is not paid, complainant's brother will be badly treated by the concerned Police. Moreover, another FIR No.639 dated 01.10.2021, Police Station Kotwali City, Ayodhya, Uttar Pradesh, under Sections 420, 419 and 170 IPC, has been registered against the petitioner. This clearly reveals about the brazen criminal antecedents of the petitioner. Furthermore, investigation is going on against the petitioner at Bengaluru also. Co-accused are yet to be arrested. Recovery of the car used in the alleged occurrence is also to be effected. Thus, to unearth the truth, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is a must.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
