On 27.05.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.50 dated 06.04.2021 registered under Sections 376, 384, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Sections 6, 12 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Section 67 of Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot, District Pathankot (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been summoned as an additional accused on an application filed under Section 319 Cr.P.C. He submits that the petitioner,

who is accused of threatening the minor-prosecutrix, is ready to surrender before the Trial Court and join the proceedings.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Amandeep Singh Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and joins the proceedings, the Trial Court shall release him on interim bail subject to his furnishing adequate surety/bail bonds to its satisfaction.

List on 17.08.2022.”

Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record copy of the order dated 02.06.2022 passed by the Trial Court to submit that the petitioner has surrendered before the Court concerned and has been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, order dated 27.05.2022 is made absolute.

Petition is disposed of.
