HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No. 5.

Petitioner is a senior citizen aged about 73 year. His grievance is that respondent No.5 has been repeatedly filing false complaints against him. As many as five separate inquiries have been conducted on the multiple complaints filed by him and the complaints have been found to be false. As a result of these complaints the petitioner is repeatedly being called to the Police Station and is facing constant harassment at the hands of respondent No.5.

Without in any way opining on the contentions of the petitioner the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 that in case the presence of the petitioner is required in connection with any complaint/inquiry/investigation, the procedure as per Cr.P.C. be strictly followed.
