On 14.11.2022, the following order was passed:

“Prayer in this petition is for setting aside the order dated 20.11.2018, passed by the trial Court, vide which the petitioner was declared a proclaimed person in the proceedings under a criminal complaint filed by respondent No. 1 under Section 138 of the N. I. Act as well as for setting aside the order dated 05.08.2019, vide which the warrants of attachment were issued.

Vide order dated 19.11.2020, on an undertaking given by the petitioner that she is ready to explore the possibility of some amicable settlement and in order to show her bona fide, she would hand over a demand draft of Rs. 3,00,000/- to respondent No.1/complainant, she was granted the concession of interim bail.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 1 has brought to the notice of this Court that despite the lapse of a period of about two years, the petitioner has neither paid

the said amount as volunteered by her nor she has appeared before the trial Court.

In view of the same, the present petition is dismissed.
