The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.70 dated 27.3.2018 registered under Sections 323, 324, 498-A, 148, 149 IPC (later on added sections 406, 326 IPC) at Police Station, Patran, District Patiala.

By virtue of the order dated 24.11.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 24.11.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent no.2 has however opposed the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 24.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
