Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.132 dated 07.05.2022 registered under Sections 186, 332, 353 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in the order dated 23.05.2022 of Additional Sessions Judge, Section 506 is also mentioned), at Police Station Sector 17, Faridabad.

Vide orders dated 27.05.2022 and 22.08.2022, the matter had been relegated to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Faridabad, and of this Court, respectively, for an amicable settlement, if any, between the parties.

As per the report, the parties could not arrive at any amicable settlement.

Status report dated 18.08.2022, by way of affidavit of the Assistant Commissioner of Police, Old Faridabad, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.

Vide order dated 27.05.2022 passed by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioner had been granted *ad interim* pre-arrest bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 27.05.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
