This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to medically de-categorize the petitioner and grant him light duty in light of the injury suffered by him and as per recommendations of Civil Hospital, Sector 6, Panchkula, vide medical prescription dated 29.01.2022 (Annexure P4) and by PGIMER, Chandigarh vide medical prescription dated 16.03.2022/30.03.2022 (Annexure P-7).

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has already filed a detailed representation dated 02.04.2022 (Annexure P8) before the respondents, but till date, no action has been taken thereon; and the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondents take a conscious decision on the same and pass a speaking order thereon, within a time

bound frame.
