The petitioner herein is seeks a writ to be issued in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab to consider and decide his revision-cum-mercy petition, dated 22.03.2022, Annexure P-4, filed against the order of dismissal from service.

Counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case his revision-cum-mercy petition ventilating his grievance, pending before respondent No.2, is decided, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Deepali Puri, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the revision-cum-mercy petition of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

Without commenting on merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide revision-cum-mercy petition, dated 22.03.2022, Annexure P-4 of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
