The present petition has been filed with a prayer that the respondents be directed to correct the information with regard to the spouse's name of petitioner No.1 in the pension payment order, so that the wife of petitioner No.1 do not suffer any prejudice at a later stage.

From the pleadings, it transpires that the date of birth and name of the wife of petitioner No.1 needs to be corrected in the documents, which are being maintained by the respondents.

A bare perusal of the averments would show that the petitioners have already raised the same grievance before the respondents by serving legal notices dated 08.11.2021 (Annexures P-4 and P-5) and the interest of justice will be served, in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notices dated 08.11.2021 (Annexures P-4 and P-5), by passing the appropriate speaking orders.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma,

Additional A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notices dated 08.11.2021 (Annexures P-4 and P-5), filed by the petitioners, in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and without going into merits of the claim as raised by the petitioners in the present case as well as in the legal notices dated 08.11.2021 (Annexures P-4 and P-5), this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to pass the appropriate speaking orders on the legal notices dated 08.11.2021 (Annexures P-4 and P-5), filed by the petitioners, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
