Through the present petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 81 dated 21.02.2018, registered under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to appear before the learned trial Court and confines his prayer to the extent to the issuance of direction to the learned trial Court to decide the application for bail of the petitioner within a stipulated period.
