For the last 04 consecutive dates none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Through the present petition the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the State to provisionally consider him for the post of Male Constable (General Duty) against the posts reserved for Special Backward Class.

On 16.05.2019 when the instant petition came up for preliminary hearing, after duly noticing that the State had already withdrawn the reservation made by it under Special Backward Class and had converted all the posts earlier reserved under that category to General Category, this Court issued notice with a further direction that as an interim measure the petitioner be provisionally considered for the post of Male Constable (General Duty) but under the General quota.

Apparently, the petitioner accepted the conversion of the Special Backward Category posts to General Category as thereafter he did not amend his petition to challenge such conversion. Rather, under the interim orders of this Court, without any protest whatsoever, he provisionally took part in the selection process.

On October 17, 2022 the final result of the entire selection process, which included the result of the performance by the petitioner, was produced before this Court in a sealed cover on the opening of which it was revealed that the last person selected and appointed as Male Constable (General Duty) had secured 64.5 marks whereas the petitioner could secure only 61 marks.

In the light of the above, the present petition does not merit acceptance.

Dismissed.
