This is the petitioner's 5th attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.67 dated 20.07.2019 registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station, STF Phase-4, District Mohali.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner was apprehended with 700 ampules of Buprenorphine and 250 ampules of Phenergan. The petitioner does not have clean criminal antecedents. Two more FIRs under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, are also pending against him. Hence, no fresh ground to grant concession of bail to the petitioner is made out.
