The petitioner herein is seeking extension of interim bail which had been allowed to him by an order dated 10.02.2022 till 01.03.2022. Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would argue that thereafter on account of continued medical condition of the petitioner, he was unable to surrender on said date and moved an application for extension of interim bail which was declined vide impugned order dated 22.04.2022. It is thereafter the petitioner has approached this Court. Counsel would submit that a stent had been introduced to stabilize the condition of the petitioner herein which has to be removed and there is a date given by the Fortis Hospital for 10.06.2022. It is submitted that he is a chronic pancreatic patient with side complications of diabetes etc. and because of his extreme ill-health would not get the necessary treatment while he was in custody.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have also perused the medical record produced in Court. There is no doubt that the petitioner is suffering from acute pancreatic failure which also has led to complications of diabetes etc. The petitioner had already been allowed interim bail by this Court. However, it appears that he has not surrendered on the date he was supposed to do so. The plea taken is that the petitioner continued to remain unwell.

Taking into account all the above factors, this Court deems it appropriate to allow his interim bail to be extended till 20.06.2022 taking into consideration that there is a procedure fixed for 10.06.2022. This would be subject to the petitioner furnishing his undertaking before the trial Court that he will surrender on or before the said date and shall also furnish surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court, which would stand forfeited to the State in case he does not surrender on the date so fixed.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
