1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 05.08.2021, in CWP-14760-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, 05.08.2021, reveals that CWP-14760-2021, was disposed of by directing the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 09.01.2020 as also by keeping in view the contentions raised in the writ petition and by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision in respect thereto in accordance with law, within three months from the date of order and if a favourable was passed, benefits in respect thereof be accorded to the petitioner within 30 days thereafter.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, has filed reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Anil Birla, Civil Surgeon, Rohtak along with administrative order

Annexure R/1 dated 15.07.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 15.07.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
