As per the report received from the trial Court, the prosecution evidence has since been closed and the case is fixed for today i.e. 14.11.2022 for recording of statement of accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

It being so, since the trial is at fag end and is likely to be concluded in near future, no ground is made out to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner, during the pendency of the trial.

Therefore, the petition for grant of regular bail is hereby dismissed. However, the trial Court is directed to make earnest efforts to conclude the trial expeditiously preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Of course accused

shall appear in the Court on the date of hearing and not take unnecessary adjournments for producing defence evidence and counsel shall address arguments in the case on the date fixed.
