[1] Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 19.02.2021.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) dated 19.02.2021 reveals that CWP No.2176 of 2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to take appropriate decision on letter dated 07.10.2020 addressed to him by the Executive Engineer, 'OP' Division Manesar, DHBVN, Gurugram.

[3] Learned counsel contends that pursuant to the filing of the instant petition, respondent No.2 has taken a decision on letter dated 07.10.2020 vide order dated 25.08.2021 in continuation of earlier order dated 09.04.2021 and in view of the said orders having been supplied to the petitioner, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

letter dated 07.10.2020 in compliance of order dated 19.02.2021 in CWP No.2176 of 2021, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against respondent No.2.

[5] The contempt petition is *disposed of* accordingly.
