Rejoinder filed on behalf of the petitioner in response to the
reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that some
of the benefits for which the petitioner was entitled for, have already been
released to him during the pendency of the present petition but grievance
with regard to the correct calculation of those benefits still persists along
with grant of interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the
petitioner intends to approach the respondent by filing appropriate
representation claiming the said benefits and the respondent may kindly be
directed to decide the same expeditiously by passing an appropriate
speaking order.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the petitioner approaches the respondent by filing a representation, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order on the said representation will be passed within a period of 8 weeks of receipt of a copy of this order and in case, after the decision on the representation, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will be released to him within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the statement of learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
