This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.70 dated 03.06.2021 registered under Sections 323, 506, 147, 188 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 3 of Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and Section 52(B) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005 at Police Station Division No.1, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the State has pointed out that one Gurwinder Singh Sandhu is also a victim in the present case and the same

has not been made as party respondent. It is also submitted that Jatinderjit Singh although has signed the compromise but the same has not been made as party. It is further contended that earlier also, a petition bearing No.CRM-M-11351-2022 had been filed, which also contained certain inadvertent mistakes.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks one last opportunity to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after making all the necessary persons as parties and after furnishing correct and full particulars.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
