This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 123 dated 14.09.2008 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Raikot, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising on the basis of the compromise.

On 15.01.2019, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner and thereafter, on 16.08.2019, again no one had appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has submitted that in the present case, FIR is of the year 2008 and all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and the case is fixed for defence evidence.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner either to rebut the abovesaid fact or to state that the compromise in the present

case is still effective.

In view of the same, the present petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise in case the compromise is still alive and the parties are ready to get their statements recorded. The question as to whether at the said stage, the quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise can be entertained or not, would be considered in case such a petition is filed.
