The present petition has been filed seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners be protected as the petitioners apprehend threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though, the private respondents are related to the petitioners but, keeping in view the dispute, which is pending between the parties, the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents, which apprehension has already been brought to the notice of respondent No.3 by way of filing representation dated 19.05.2021

(Annexure P/1), which is still pending consideration with the said respondent, which fact is causing prejudice to the petitioners.

Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions that representation dated 19.05.2021 (Annexure P/1) submitted by the petitioners to respondent No.3 will be decided within a period of 08 weeks from today by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 and 5 submits that before deciding the representation dated 19.05.2021 (Annexure P/1) submitted by the petitioners, respondents No.4 and 5 be also heard so that the factual aspects can be brought to the notice of the authority concerned.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in representation dated 19.05.2021 (Annexure P/1), respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 19.05.2021 (Annexure P/1) submitted by the petitioners after hearing all the parties concerned by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
