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**VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)**

At the very outset, it has been brought to the notice of the Court by learned State counsel that there is an error with regard to the particulars of the FIR as mentioned in the petition. In the petition, the date of FIR No. 55 has been mentioned as 06.09.2017. However, the perusal of the vernacular of FIR indicates that the originally the FIR was registered on 04.08.2017 and the system date has been mentioned as 06.09.2017.

In these circumstances, the particulars of the FIR, which has been sought to be quashed have to be taken as FIR No. 55 dated 04.08.2017 under Sections 498-A, 406, 120-B IPC, Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur.

Learned State counsel has further pointed out that Amarjit Singh and others had instituted a petition for quashing the FIR on the basis of compromise bearing CRM-M-48777-2018. The petition has been

allowed and the FIR No. 55 dated 04.08.2017 and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom have been quashed qua the petitioners on the basis of the compromise dated 17.09.2018 in terms of order dated May 22, 2019. As the FIR has been quashed, nothing survives in the petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
