1. This is a petition seeking quashing of order dated 4th December, 2007, passed by learned SDJM, Phul whereby the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender in case of FIR No. 129, dated 17th July, 2006, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura.

2. Learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that the petitioner was acquitted in case of FIR No. 129, dated 17th July, 2006.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that after declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender FIR No. 95, dated 27th September, 2016, under Section 174-A, was registered at Police Station Phul and she was convicted.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner is not having instructions to contradict the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents.

5. The petition is disposed of.

6. However, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of grievance, if any.
