Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.61 dated 06.05.2022 registered under Sections 406, 498-A and 323 IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar, Rural, Punjab.

On 06.06.2022 this Court had passed the following order: -

“ Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.61 dated 06.05.2022 under Sections 406, 498- A and 323 IPC registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the FIR in question just to exert pressure on the husband of the complainant. Learned counsel submits that general and vague allegations of demand of dowry have been made in the FIR which are not substantiated by any material evidence. Learned counsel further submits that there are no specific allegations of beating against the petitioner on the day when the complainant left her matrimonial home i.e. 01.09.2019.

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when called upon to do so. In the event of her arrest, she shall be admitted to interim bail on her furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. ”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined investigation and that her custodial interrogation is not required by the State.

In the light of the reasons stated in the afore quoted order as also the statement made on behalf of the State, the order of this Court dated 06.06.2022, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
