[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 23.09.2019 in CWP No.27161 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.27161 of 2019 was disposed of with a direction to the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 02.07.2019 filed by the petitioners in accordance with law within six weeks from the receipt of certified copy of the judgment and in case, on consideration, the competent authority came to the conclusion that the request made by the petitioners was admissible, in such eventuality the consequential relief was to be allowed to them within six weeks thereafter.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that claim of the petitioners as contained in the representation dated 02.07.2019 has been decided by the competent authority vide order dated

01.03.2021, therefore, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
