Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of criminal complaint bearing No.73/2/11 dated 07.05.2011, under Section 3(k) (i), 17, 18, 29 and 33 of the Insecticide Act, 1968 read with Rules 27(5) of the Insecticide Rules, 1971 and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom including summoning order dated 07.05.2011 (Annexure P-2).
