GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.68 dated 08.07.2017 registered at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 323/452/148/149/506 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 31.05.2022, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SBS Nagar, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners, namely, Gurdev Singh, Harpreet Singh, Harpreet Singh @ Tida and Charanjit Ram as well as of complainant Manjit Singh

and injured Punjab Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Manjit Singh and injured Punjab Singh in their statements have stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SBS Nagar, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise without any coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.68 dated 08.07.2017 registered at Police Station Behram, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 323/452/148/149/506 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
