VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.40 dated 22.04.2020 registered under Sections 452, 427, 506, 148, 149, 188 IPC at Police Station D-Division, District Amritsar City and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 01.10.2020, a coordinate Bench of this Court had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court to give statement in support of compromise. However, as per the report of the trial Court, the parties had not appeared. On 18.01.2021, a coordinate Bench of this Court had again granted opportunity to the parties for recording their statements in respect of

compromise. As per the report of the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar, the parties have not appeared.

In view of the above, it seems that the compromise has not fructified and accordingly, the present petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the parties to file a fresh petition for quashing of the above said FIR on the basis of compromise in case compromise is still effectual and parties are ready to get their statements recorded in respect of the compromise.
