Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.165 dated 12.07.2018, registered for offences under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of settlement agreement dated 01.05.2019, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Counsel representing complainant-respondent No.2 submits that although the complainant had appeared before the Trial Court and her statement had been recorded in support of the compromise, but after taking her home, the petitioners have thrown her out of her matrimonial home. He has instructions to oppose the petition.

Faced with this development, counsel for the petitioners seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
