1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 30.03.2022, in CWP-26726-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 30.03.2022 in CWP-26726-2021 reveals that the matter was relegated to the authorities concerned for reconsidering decision of debarring the petitioner as well as the period of three years for which the petitioner had been debarred.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, states that pursuant to order Annexure P/1, claim of the petitioner was considered after complying with the principles of natural justice, but the claim has been rejected vide order Annexure R/2 dated 24.06.2022.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order Annexure R/2 dated 24.06.2022, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same,

with liberty to challenge order Annexure R/2 dated 24.06.2022, by way of

appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
6. Rule discharged.
