Through this instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case bearing FIR No.32 dated 24.04.2021 registered under Sections 307, 341, 323, 324, 148, 149, 506 IPC, at Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 26.07.2021 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 26.07.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sucha Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 26.07.2021 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
