On 11.07.2022 the following order had been passed by this court:-

“By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.17, dated 06.03.2021, having been registered at Police Station GRP, Sonipat, alleging therein the commission of offence punishable under Sections 379-B/34 of the IPC (with Sections 201/411 of the IPC added later).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the primary offence being one punishable under Section 379-B of the IPC and with the complainant having turned hostile, there would no reason to keep the petitioner in further custody, he already having been in such custody for about 1 year and 4 months.

Learned State counsel on the other hand submits that all evidence has already been recorded by the trial court, with only

arguments now to be addressed on 25.07.2022.

In view of the fact that the complainant is stated to have been turned hostile and there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner even as per the instructions of learned State counsel from SI Suresh Kumar, the petitioner is order to be admitted to interim bail, upon him furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court, till the next date of hearing before this court.

Adjourned to 29.07.2022.”

Learned State counsel submits, on instructions, that the trial is at the stage of defence evidence now, with the next date of hearing being 08.08.2022.

In view of the above, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the order dated 11.07.2022 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.
