Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.34 dated 27.05.2021, registered under Sections 22(c) and 29 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been indicted in the present case on the basis of the disclosure statement of the co-accused and that the alleged recovery of 4200 tablets marka Tramadol, had already been effected from the co-accused.

I have heard the learned counsel for the petitioner.

The recovery effected in the present case falls under the commercial quantity and Section 37 of the NDPS Act bars the grant of bail to the accused in case of a commercial quantity. Furthermore, another FIR No.69 dated 07.04.2021 under NDPS Act, is registered and pending against the petitioner. Therefore, the complicity of the petitioner of involving himself in one after the another case, speaks volume. Thus, to unearth the truth and the details of the other co-accused involved

in the offence, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is a must.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
