1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 01.04.2022, in CRWP-9176-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, dated 01.04.2022, reveals that CRWP-9176-2021, was disposed of by directing the Secretary, Government of Punjab, Home Department, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh, to decide representation dated 18.08.2021, by passing a speaking order within 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 16.07.2022, passed by the Additional Chief Secretary, Government of Punjab, Department of Jail, recommending rejection of the premature release case of the petitioner on account of his not fulfilling the minimum prescribed period of punishment required to be undergone. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel

the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to file a fresh writ petition seeking premature release on fulfilling the conditions stipulated under the rules/policies. The same is not opposed to by the learned AAG, Punjab.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
