1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 21.04.2022, in CWP-8024-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-8024-2022, was disposed of on the statement of the learned Addl. Advocate General that the respondent authorities would consider and pass a detailed order on representation dated 09.04.2022 expeditiously and communicate the same to the petitioner.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of decision having been taken on representation dated 09.04.2022, vide order dated 09.04.2022, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 08.08.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
