Petitioner is seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents/State to grant emergency parole to the petitioner for a period of four weeks to enable him to perform the marriage ceremonies of his sister's daughter namely Preeti and son namely Vikas respectively which are fixed for dated 21.06.2022 and 23.06.2022 (wrongly typed as 21.05.2022 to 23.05.2022) at Village Kharhar, District Jhajjar (Annexure P-2).

In compliance with the order dated 31.05.2022, verification report has been filed by the learned State counsel. As per verification report done by Station House Officer, P.S.Bahu-Akbarpur, Rohtak, dated 01.06.2022 (Annexure R-1), marriage of Preeti (niece of convict Jai Bhagwan) is to be solemnized on 21.06.2022 and the marriage of the nephew Vijay is fixed for 23.06.2022. The same report has been made by the Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat, Kharar, District Jhajjar (Annexure P-2) and Randhir Singh and Rajesh (residents of same village) which was duly

attested by ASI, P.S. Bahu Akbarpur, dated 23.05.2022 (Annexure P-3).

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by giving directions to the respondents to release the petitioner on parole on 18.06.2022 for attending the said marriage ceremonies to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, concerned. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the Jail Authorities on 02.07.2022 (forenoon).
